## Seminar: August 17, 18, & 19



Shidoshi Robert Mattson will be sharing the latest techniques from Japan during this three-day seminar. He has been training in the Bujinkan arts for more than thirty years including a total of six years living and training in Japan. Before discovering the art of Ninpo-Taijutsu he was a blackbelt instructor of sport-style martial arts. Shidoshi Robert will focus on the current training including ninjato strategies, muto against various weapons, and unarmed taijutsu. During this trip Hatsumi-Soke presented Robert with the Daishihan Certificate and his son Tohbi with a Tiger Scroll. This high-level training is based on the distance, timing, and taijutsu that is important at all levels.
